

Duran Duran: Red Carpet Massacre World Tour



After six months playing venues in Europe, the United States, Australia and Asia, Duran Duran finally took their Red Carpet Massacre World Tour to South America, their first time there since 2006.

The band's South American tour featured its best line-up, with original members Simon LeBon, Nick Rhodes, John Taylor and Roger Taylor, and started on 4 November 2008 in Lima (Peru), ending in December 2008 with two concerts in São Paulo and Rio De Janeiro. The lighting system, installed by LPL Lighting Production LTDA, included **24 XM 1200 SPOT moving heads**.

The XM 1200's were fitted on three parallel trusses above the stage, with **seven fixed to posts hung from the rear truss (height 8 metres), six hung from the central truss (9 metres) and seven hung from the front truss (10 metres)**. Four more XM1200 SPOT's were placed at ground level, behind the band.
